Code of Conduct

Burlington Radio Controlled Modelers (“the Club”) is a non-profit organization with the following objectives:

- To promote interest in the safe operation of all types of model aircraft through cooperation between members and with the public
- To develop and maintain communication between similar modeling organizations through national and international organizations
- To encourage, organize and promote recreational flying with other like-minded individuals and organizations.

Members have a right to:

1. Be treated fairly, equally and with respect by the Club, the board, and other members.
2. Socialise in an environment free from all forms of harassment and discrimination.
3. Be informed and actively involved in all club events and offerings.
4. Enjoy a safe, friendly and fun environment to discuss building and flying model aircraft.

Members must:

1. Treat other members, guests and spectators fairly, equally and with respect and courtesy.
2. Adhere and abide by the rules, policies, procedures, and bylaws of the Club.
3. Report any inappropriate behaviour of a member to the board for action and follow up.
4. Support the decisions and directions of the board and the Club.

Breaches of this Code of Conduct:

- The board and/or the Club may respond to inappropriate behaviour with a reprimand, suspension or revocation of membership.
